2009-2010 School Year

We have recently begun the building of the Tsad Kadima Educational-Rehabilitative Center in Beer Sheba. We hope to open the new center on 9/2010. The cornerstone ceremony took place on June in the presence of Mr. Rubik Danilovitz – the mayor of Beer Sheba, his deputies, representatives of the donors, the Institution for National Insurance, senior members for the Beer Sheba Municipality and Tsad Kadima representatives. The year 2008-2009 was the 4th and last year of the implementation of the 4 year work plan. The broad scope of Tsad Kadima’s activities and growth over the years require well planned and responsible organization.

To enable this, a new 4 year work-plan was prepared and approved by the board for the

years 9/2009 – 8/2013).

Tsad Kadima’s Annual General Assembly took place on July 2009. The financial reports, auditor’s report and the executive director’s report for the year 2008 were approved. The board, chairperson and committee members were elected. It should be noted that we executed our year-plan within the approved budget despite the global economic crisis.

Tsad Kadima underwent a transparency, reliability, stability and efficiency evaluation by “Midot”, a non-profit, unique initiative, which mainly assesses non-profit organizations in Israel. We are happy and proud to announce that the grade we received is 4.5 (out of 5), which reflects on the rate of investment confidence in Tsad Kadima for donors, foundations, businesses and volunteers (the full report is on our website: www.tsadkadima.org.il).


